- Alberta District School Counsel Engagement Award went to EIPS
- Alexis Kotronis is the Edwin Parr teacher nominee
- o Board approved 3 year capital plan
  - Expansions, renovations, new school buildings for multiple schools in district
- o Budget is the same, although we didn't get funding for inflation
  - didn't get funded for insurance and utility increase, so we have had to dip into reserves; may need to look at wants vs needs for future;
  - Grant for 'reset rooms' is ending in June
  - Everyone gets transportation rebate (40% rebate to current student riders)
  - Thank you that we are encouraging our kids at home and cheering them on
